**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE YOMBA SHOSHONE TRIBE
CERTIFICATION OF OFFICIAL SPECIAL ELECTION RESULTS of February 14, 2026**

WHEREAS, “BE IT ENACTED BY THE YOMBA SHOSHONE TRIBAL COUNCIL” to be the Governing body for the Yomba Shoshone Reservation, proclaimed on October 27, 1938 under the Congressional Act, the Yomba Shoshone Tribe is Federally Recognized under the Indian Reorganization Act (IRA) 1934, 25 U.S.C. and was established to exercise the privileges and powers of self-government, to conserve and develop the Tribe's resources for the social and economic well-being of its members, and to preserve and protect the civil rights of its members; and;

WHEREAS, the Yomba Shoshone Tribe is federally recognized by the United States Government and the Secretary of the Interior as a Native American Tribe, and by the power vested in the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws, the Council has the authority to manage all affairs of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 3 of the Tribal Constitution provides that upon receipt of a petition signed by at least 30% of the qualified voters calling for the recall of any Council member, including a Chairman, the Council shall call a special election to decide the matter; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee validated a recall petition against Chairman Darryl Brady, and the Tribal Council called a special election in accordance with Article V, Section 3 and Election Ordinance No. YST2014-02; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution provides that the Tribal Council shall declare the existence of a vacancy and shall appoint a tribal member to fill the position until the next regular election, and that such vacancy may be filled by special election; and

WHEREAS, a special election was held on February 14, 2026, with two matters on the ballot: (1) the recall of Chairman Darryl Brady, and (2) the election of a Vice Chairman to fill the existing vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Board conducted the special election in accordance with the Tribal Constitution and Election Ordinance No. YST2014-02 and has certified the results;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Yomba Shoshone Tribal Council hereby certifies the results of the Special Election held on February 14, 2026, as follows: a) Recall of Chairman Darryl Brady. The question of recall of Chairman Darryl Brady was submitted to the qualified voters of the Yomba Shoshone Tribe. The results are as follows: Votes in favor of removal: 18, Votes against removal: 0, Total votes cast: 18. The recall has been approved by a majority of voters. Darryl Brady is hereby officially removed from the position of Chairman of the Yomba Shoshone Tribal Council, effective immediately and b) Election of Vice Chairman. The election for Vice Chairman to fill the existing vacancy was submitted to the qualified voters of the Yomba Shoshone Tribe. The results are as follows: Votes for Christopher Dyer: 18, Votes against: 0, Total votes cast: 18. Christopher Dyer has been elected to the position of Vice Chairman of the Yomba Shoshone Tribal Council, effective immediately.

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE YOMBA SHOSHONE TRIBE
CERTIFICATION OF OFFICIAL SPECIAL ELECTION RESULTS of February 14, 2026**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: the position of Chairman is now vacant. The Tribal Council shall take action to fill this vacancy in accordance with Article V, Section 1 of the Tribal Constitution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Darryl Brady shall immediately relinquish all authority, records, documents, keys, passwords, and tribal property associated with the office of Chairman to the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Christopher Dyer shall assume all duties and responsibilities of the Vice Chairman position upon taking the oath of office as prescribed by the Constitution and Bylaws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Tribal Council directs that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Western Nevada Agency, and all relevant federal, state, and local agencies be notified of these election results and the current composition of the Tribal Council.
